

2019 Annual Report Supplement (Reporting period 7/1/18 – 6/30/19)

Eastern Sandoval County Arroyo Flood Control Authority (ESCAFCA)

This document is provided as a supplement to the EPA Annual Report form used to provide more explanation to responses provided in the Annual Report form.

Section 1, NPDES Number: The pdf form provided by the EPA does not allow for non-numeric data entry in this field. The NPDES number for our permit is NMR04A000

Section 4: ESCAFCA only has jurisdictional authority over five small ESCAFCA-owned projects. The boxes checked in section 4 of the Annual Report are in the context of ESCAFCA-owned projects only.

Section 5: ESCAFCA has no outfalls to receiving water.

Section 6: ESCAFCA has indicated “no” to these program elements. ESCAFCA does not currently own or operate any of the types of facilities indicated in the Annual Report.

Section 7.A: ESCAFCA has indicated “no” on all program elements. ESCAFCA does not have authority to create ordinances. ESCAFCA conducts other agency and peer review of its projects, and seeks comments from other jurisdictions, as appropriate.

Section 7.D: ESCAFCA has indicated “no” on this program element. ESCAFCA is required by State Law, to abide by the 96 hour rule, requiring all flood control facilities to discharge all detained stormwater within 96 hours.

Section 7.E: ESCAFCA has indicated “no” on all program elements. ESCAFCA-owned projects are flood control projects that generate little to no excess stormwater on site as these projects are not constructed from impermeable materials. These projects are constructed to manage up-stream flows and attenuate the hydrograph so that stormwater can be conveyed safely through downstream facilities.

Section 7.I, 7.J and 7.L: ESCAFCA does not have statutory authority to regulate private development.
